The Presbytery of Waterloo Wellington Covid Assistance Fund established in March of this year, allowed congregations to apply for up to \$10,000 for projects that would assist their congregation or community to adjust to Covid. Admiring the Christmas trees displayed in his neighbour's windows, Nathan asks his father, "Daddy, can we have a Hanukkah Tree?"



