

Lent is an annual Christian period that starts on Ash Wednesday lasting for 40 days (not including Sundays) representing the 40 days Jesus spent fasting in the wilderness. This 40 day period for Christians is a time to reflect, fast, and give penance in preparation for the resurrection of Christ Easter Sunday.

On Sunday January 28, both congregations welcomed new members.to their fellowship.




St. Andrew's were blessed to welcome Deanne, Marie and Bob.


“My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth” (1 John 3:18). Don't just talk the talk, but walk the walk. Show your love to others.
